## **Frequently Asked Questions & Membership Benefits of ALGWA SA Branch Inc Organisation Membership**

**Q. *When does membership start and end?***

A. Annual membership is from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> June. The organisation is not registered for GST. Our association operates with volunteers and relies on its members' subscriptions and fundraising. We provide member benefits, such as informal mentoring, networking and discount for events.

**Q. *If half of the year has passed, do we to get a reduced rate for the rest of this financial year?***

A. No. Our constitution only has annual membership for both individual and organisation membership regardless of time of joining.

**Q. *How many employees does organisational membership cover?***

A. Our Organisation membership is not based on any numbers of employees or elected members. However, it does require the organisation to appoint a representative (staff or, in case of a Council, it could be a staff or an elected member) who is entitled to one vote at any ALGWA SA Branch Inc Annual General Meeting or special meeting. It is preferred that the representative should champion and reflect support for ALGWA SA Inc aims and communicate in a timely manner as required between ALGWA SA Branch Inc and the representative's Council staff and elected members.

**Q. *If an Organisation joins, do individuals from the organisation still need individual membership?***

A. Yes. Individual membership, currently \$45 annually, provides for individuals to join and belong in their own right, entitled to one vote at any ALGWA SA Branch Inc general, including the Annual General Meeting or special meetings and to have individual invitations to events and other benefits.

NOTE: Individual Membership is open to women and men involved in local government supporting the Association's aims. Although the Association is primarily for women in local government, it encourages and welcomes support from men colleagues in local government.

Only one nominated Organisation Member Representative from each Organisation is entitled to a vote, however, organisations receive invitations for staff to events at free or reduced rates.

**Q. *Does it entitle staff and councillors attend events run by the Association?***

A. Yes. Many of our events are free or discounted for ALGWA SA Branch Individual Members and the Organisation Member staff and councillors (a limit may be set on attendance).

**Q. *Does the Organisation receive acknowledgement?***

A. Yes- Organisation members are acknowledged on our website.
